#### **1991**

The MacDonal Johnston Side Loader MKI was launched in August, which marked the beginning of the journey that has still not ended! Designed in Australia by Australians, this machine has helped transform the local waste industry. The MK1 broke new ground with single person operated refuse machines, excellent payloads and featured ground breaking electronics such as the 'potentiometer paddle angle control system'.

#### **1992**

Following the successful launch of the MK1 and introducing further innovation, the MKII Side Loader was released to the market after an intensive seven week re-design and build program.

#### **1995**

MKIII was released and with this new model, MacDonal Johnston introduced the Finger Lift with Vacuum Cup options to the Binlifter. Further advancements were also made to the hydraulic and electrical systems ensuring MacDonal Johnston were setting the pace in the local market.

#### **2000**

With the new millennium came a new model from MacDonal Johnston. The MKIV was launched with new and improved technological features and internal PLC control systems.

#### **2006**

The most significant changes occurred in 2006 with the launch of the revolutionary S.P.O.R.T Gen V Side Loader. This saw a total overhaul of the body design and inner technological workings, creating a machine that is **FASTER, STRONGER & MORE RELIABLE.**

#### **2011**

The Side Loader celebrates its 20<sup>th</sup> Birthday as MacDonal Johnston launches two new products to complete its stable of world class machines - the locally designed and developed **FORCE** Front Loader and **UrBin** Rear Loader products.
